

CITY-WIDE CURB-SIDE CLEAN UP DAY – FREE DISPOSAL!! – SATURDAY, APRIL 13, 2013

On Saturday, April 13, 2013, beginning at 7:00 AM, the City will be sponsoring its annual city-wide, curbside, total clean-up. Any resident** may put out at the curb large, bulky waste items. **(no appliances, tires, batteries, regular household garbage, hazardous materials, construction debris, commercial business items, “e-waste” or yard wastes will be accepted.**

All items must be out at the curb by 7:00 AM. The Garbage Contractor will not return for any items not curbside by 7AM.

Regularly scheduled **future disposal dates** will be held in the **SPRING** on the 2nd Saturday in April [**April 12, 2014**], **and** in the **FALL** on the 2nd Saturday of October [**October 12, 2013**.] For more information or if you have any questions or special needs, please feel free to call City Hall at 289-4242.

**** Only LeClaire residents (no commercial businesses) whose City garbage accounts are paid in full may participate.**

“E-waste” is defined as devices that contain a circuit board or a cathode ray tube such as, computer monitors, televisions, VCRs, stereos, computers, radios, and video game systems. ***E-waste contains environmental hazards such as lead, mercury, cadmium, nickel, chromium, lithium, and PCBs.***

“Hazardous Materials” are defined as Fluorescent Light Bulbs, household cleaners and disinfectants, vehicle fluids, Weed Killer, Bug Sprays Pesticides, fertilizers, paint, stains, varnishes, glue, solvents, etc.
