All members of the Board shall be bona fide citizens and residents of the City, or shall own and/or operate a commercial establishment within the City which meets the classification requirements of category descriptions "b" shown below, or shall be a permanent standing member of the Board by virtue of their position held on the designated organizations listed in categories "c" and "d" shown below and all directors shall have attained the age of eighteen (18) prior to the effective date of appointment and no Director, other than those as specified herein below, shall hold any elective office within the City.
