A. Executive Session per IC 21.5 c. – Litigation

B. iWork Electronic Building Permit Software

Dennis Bockenstedt, City Administrator, introduced Jon Goble, iWork, who gave an electronic overview of the software program. Council does not object to obtaining this software.

C. Canadian Pacific Merger Settlement

Dennis Bockenstedt, City Administrator, indicated that the City has received an offer in the amount of \$750,000 from Canadian Pacific and gave an overview of expenditures related to the funds. Council does not object to this offer.

D. Huckleberry & Hollyhock Parking

Dennis Bockenstedt, City Administrator, discussed updating the parking ordinance to allow parking on the east side of Huckleberry Lane and additional signage for no parking at on the east side of the lane. Greg Ludwig, Parks Director, stated that scheduling changes should help with some of the parking issues as well. Bockenstedt also stated that additional parking at Hollyhock is being investigated in advance of the dog park. Council does not object to this plan.

E. Parks & Recreation Commission Recommendation of Appointment

Greg Ludwig, Parks & Recreation Director stated that the Commission recommends the reappointment of Heather Richardel. She has been a great asset to the Commission. Council does not object to this appointment.
