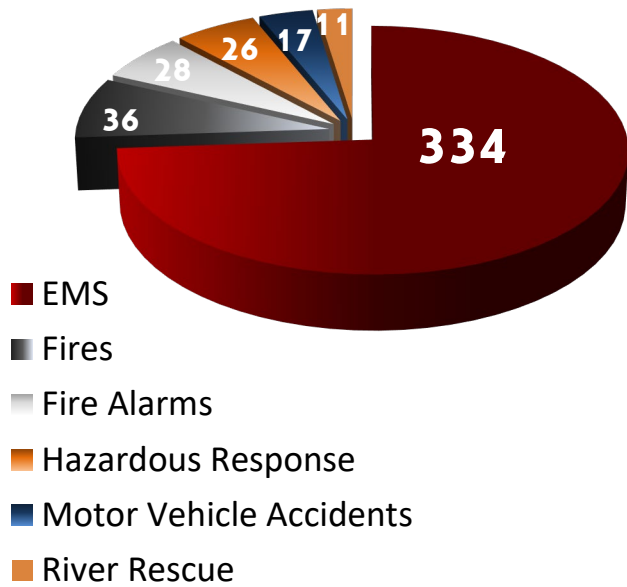
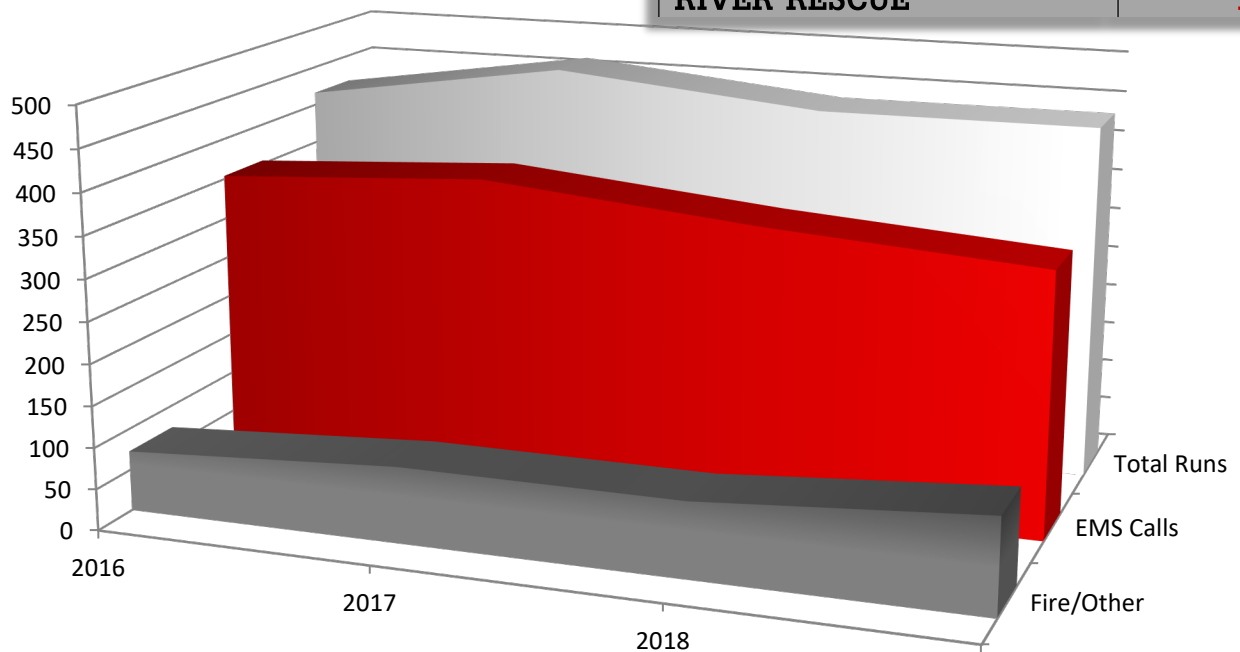

2020 FIRECHIEF REPORT



Our firefighter/EMT's responded to 452 calls in 2020 as compared to 435 calls in 2019.

In 2020 the LeClaire Fire Department remained one of the busiest volunteer department in Scott County. COVID19 made 2020 a more challenging year for the LeClaire Fire Department. Our department worked diligently to acquire the proper PPE in order to keep our members and patients safe on EMS calls.

Our department currently consists of 18 active members including 2 probationary firefighters. Our current medical staffing includes 1 EMT-Paramedics, 5 EMT-Basics, and 2 Emergency Medical Responders. 2 of our probationary firefighters are currently taking Firefighter I training requirements and both are on track to become full members in 2021.

In 2020, LeClaire Fire Department provided 3,204 volunteer hours to the community including training (1,192hrs), cleaning (240hrs), maintenance (109hrs) and calls (1,241hrs). 422hrs were spent on meetings and administrative duties. Due to the COVID19 pandemic there were a total of 17 annual events that were cancelled that are normally supported by the LeClaire Fire Department including Tugfest and Fire Prevention week activities. We normally contribute 2000+ hours towards these events annually.

The LeClaire Fire Department maintained an ISO rating of 4 out of 10 (10 being the least amount of protection). By maintaining a rating of 4, the community benefits from lowered insurance costs.
